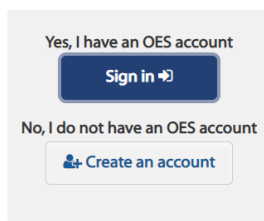


Registering for Online Employment Services

In order to initiate the registration process, you will be required to have a Basic BCeID. If you have an existing BCeID please use the same one. If you do not have one, visit www.bceid.ca to create one.

1. Access OES by visiting the WorkBC.ca website.
2. Select the **'Create an account'** button (see image), and when prompted enter your BCeID.



3. From the main application page, select **'I have an open existing WorkBC case and would like to register for Online Services'** (image below).

4. Select the active case type they have (image below).

6. Upon submission, you will receive a welcome notification via email and can begin using OES.
